

World War I Project: Scoring Guide

The purpose of this project is for you to demonstrate your understanding of the daily conditions faced by soldiers who served in World War I. You will pretend to be a soldier and write a letter home which describes the conditions you face on the battlefield.

You should be creative, write the letter in first person (“I woke up this morning and it was raining.”), and use at least five (5) terms we have covered in the textbook, PowerPoint, or in the video. Please underline these terms or put them in bold print.

Your letter should be at least 1 page in length, use a 12 point, easy-to-read font, and have 1” margins. Please use proper grammar (spelling, punctuation, verb tense, etc.).
